### Year 10 Course Selection Notes:

1. If the number of students in an elective subject is small, the subject may not proceed in 2010. Students will be advised of any changes as soon as possible.
2. A student who wishes to apply for entry to **VCE Foundation Mathematics Units 1 & 2** or **VCE Mathematical Methods 1 & 2**, must first discuss his or her intention with the **Coordinator of Mathematics, Dr Paul Matthew**.
3. The **LOTES (French, German and Japanese)** are only available to those students who have studied the subject in Year 9.
4. **VCE Music Performance Solo Units 1&2** may be offered to students as an **after school class** in lieu of an elective block subject. Students interested in this possibility should discuss the matter with the **Coordinator of Performing Arts, Mr Gavin Cornish**.
5. **Please note for future reference:** All Year 12 students are required to study five VCE Unit 3/4 subjects, in addition to any VCE 3/4 subjects completed in Year 11.
